CHARMS Demonstration - Ryan Marsh

CHARMS Office assistant is the accounts receivable and record software used by the Chorus Boosters. This system allows us to communicate with you via email listserv. It also has a student account and credit management module which students and parents can log in to track trip payments, fee payments, and other fees or credits. Charms also tracks our Choral library, uniform inventory, financial statements, student practice logs, trip ledgers, and more.

Parents can help by logging in to their student's account to keep contact information and t-shirt size current.

To log in, parents need the Lafayette Code:

- And the Kentucky student number (Infinite campus number)

M2 – Mastering Musicianship – Private Lesson Program

Statistics indicate that if a child participates in music, he or she is likely to earn higher grades and score better on standardized tests. Now there is powerful scientific evidence of a cause and effect link between music instruction and intelligence.

Lafayette's Mastering Musicianship Program, known as M2, provides for individual music lessons over a 10-week session each semester. The advantages to this program are cost and convenience. The rate for private lessons in Lexington is approximately \$15 per half-hour, or more. The M2 program at Lafayette is only \$100 for the 10-week session, and private instruction takes place in the practice rooms of the Lafayette Music department, under the direction of highly qualified music consultants.

Lessons are arranged to accommodate student needs. The majority of the lessons will occur between the hours of 3:30-7:30 pm, Monday thru Thursday. Lafayette Band students can participate too!
