The Lafayette High School Madrigal Singers from Lexington, Kentucky, under the direction of Ryan Marsh, perform high quality choral repertoire from all time periods and styles with an emphasis on world music and contemporary choral literature. The choir is internationally recognized with performances at state, regional, and national competitive and conference events to their credit. The ensemble has performed for the Kentucky Music Educators Association in 2009, 2015, 2020, and 2024, and for the ACDA Southern Division Conferences in 2010, 2018, and 2024. The Madrigal Singers were awarded two silver medals at the World Choir Games in 2012, and in 2014 at the Sing 'N' Joy international competition in Louisville, won a gold diploma and the mixed youth choir category. The choir appeared as featured performers at the Inaugural Music for All National Choir Festival in 2018 and were invited to be the demonstration choir for the conductors' masterclass with the late Dr. Joseph Flummerfelt. Through the choir's journey this year, the singers have demonstrated a meaningful commitment to the ensemble, the music, and connecting with our audiences.
